Summer School Update July 11, 2022

- 1. At the June Board meeting, the Board of Education elected to pay staff for the day missed at Blue Ridge and Westridge elementary schools on Wednesday, June 8th, due to power outage.
 - a. New Trails Early Learning Center also missed on this date. New Trails students only attend 12 days during June, so they were able to make up this date on Monday, June 27th, as required to meet students' Extended School Year minutes. Should staff at New Trails Early Learning Center also be paid for June 8th as the staff were at Blue Ridge and Westridge?
 - b. Westridge Elementary again had a power outage on Wednesday, June 22nd. Should staff at Westridge Elementary be paid for this date, as the Board elected to do for June 8th?
- 2. June data
 - a. 3,438 students participated in June.
 - b. High school students passed 1,723 courses to earn 861.5 credits.
- 3. Special learning opportunities
 - a. The Zoomobile came to Kindergarten and 1st grade at each elementary.
 - b. 2nd grade visited the Kansas City Community Gardens where they saw and tasted a variety of plants.
 - c. 3rd grade saw a student production of the Little Mermaid, and they had the opportunity to talk to the cast about putting on a play.
 - d. 4th grade visited the Zoo to see several animals they discussed in their classes.
 - e. 5th grade participated in Junior Achievement's BizTown, a simulation of learning how to interact as different roles of businesses in a city.
- 4. July high school online classes
 - a. 204 high school students enrolled in first time credit online classes.
 - b. Some high school students are finishing Fuel Ed courses to complete credit recovery.
