The Raytown C-2 School District provides a summer program for every student free of charge. This program is designed to give all students a "Smart Start" to the fall semester. Smart Start is a fun, interactive, educational program for students entering kindergarten through 12th grade in the fall of 2018. The program is designed to help students maintain the skills they acquired during the regular school year and help them obtain new skills for the following school year. In addition to mathematics, communication arts, and either science or social studies, students K-8 will engage in a variety of exploratory courses. Students who will be enrolled in grades 9-12 can earn first time credit, recover credit, or learn more about a particular topic during the summer. For most courses, high school students can earn a ½ unit of credit for successfully passing, and their course grade contributes to their overall high school GPA.

Attendance

- Raytown Middle School students will attend Raytown Middle School (7:55-2:55)
- Raytown Central Middle School students will attend Raytown South Middle School if they are in the attendance area of Blue Ridge or will attend Raytown Middle School if they are in the Norfleet or Robinson attendance areas (7:55-2:55)
- Raytown South Middle School students will attend Raytown South Middle School (7:55-2:55)

Enrolling in the Correct Smart Start Grade Level

Students should enroll in the grade level they will be entering in the Fall of 2018. For example, a current 5th-grade student will enroll in Smart Start 6th Grade.

Food Service

Breakfast and lunch will be free for students attending Summer School 2018. Lunch and breakfast will continue to be served in accordance with current USDA nutritional guidelines. Students will still have the opportunity to purchase a la carte items. A la carte pricing can be found in each café and can be located on the Raytown Food Service web page. Charges will not be allowed during Summer School for a la carte purchases.

Advanced Courses

Students who meet academic, discipline, and attendance requirements may be recommended to enroll in Advanced 7th Grade Science or 8th Grade Geography and 8th Grade Communications. Advanced 7th Grade Science during the summer is a prerequisite for students who wish to enroll in Advanced 7th Grade Science during Fall 2018. Students are allowed to miss only one day of the summer session. Additionally, students must earn at least a C to enroll in Advanced 7th Grade Science in the fall. Successful completion of this entire course will enable students to take Physical Science for high school credit their 8th-grade year.

Eligible students entering 8th grade in Fall 2018 can enroll in Geography and/or Communications for High School credit. Each class will meet ½ day at both middle schools. Enrollment in Advanced Courses is limited. Students will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

Communications, Geography, and Advanced 7th Grade Science are half-day classes. If a student chooses not to enroll in another half day class, his/her parent will be responsible for transportation at mid-day.

IMPORTANT: Because the 8th-grade advanced classes count for high school credit, students must attend at least 60 hours to receive credit. Grades earned in these classes will be recorded on the student's high school transcript.

For Students Not Currently Attending Raytown Schools: PAPER ENROLLMENT

Parents who reside in the Raytown School District and have a student not currently attending Raytown Schools must complete the "Students not Currently Enrolled in Raytown Schools" Enrollment Form packet in paper format.
