Donor Development

- Endowment Fund REF has received a generous donation from the Walter A. and Charlotte Soule Family Foundation, enabling the Raytown Educational Foundation to establish an endowment fund at Truman Heartland Community Foundation. The endowment fund will support current and future REF programs including scholarships, grants and student recognition.
- **Graduating Senior Scholarship Fund** The Raytown High School Class of 1970 established a new scholarship fund for Raytown High School graduates. The first scholarship will be awarded to a member from the Class of 2025.
