2. Overall, vision, budget

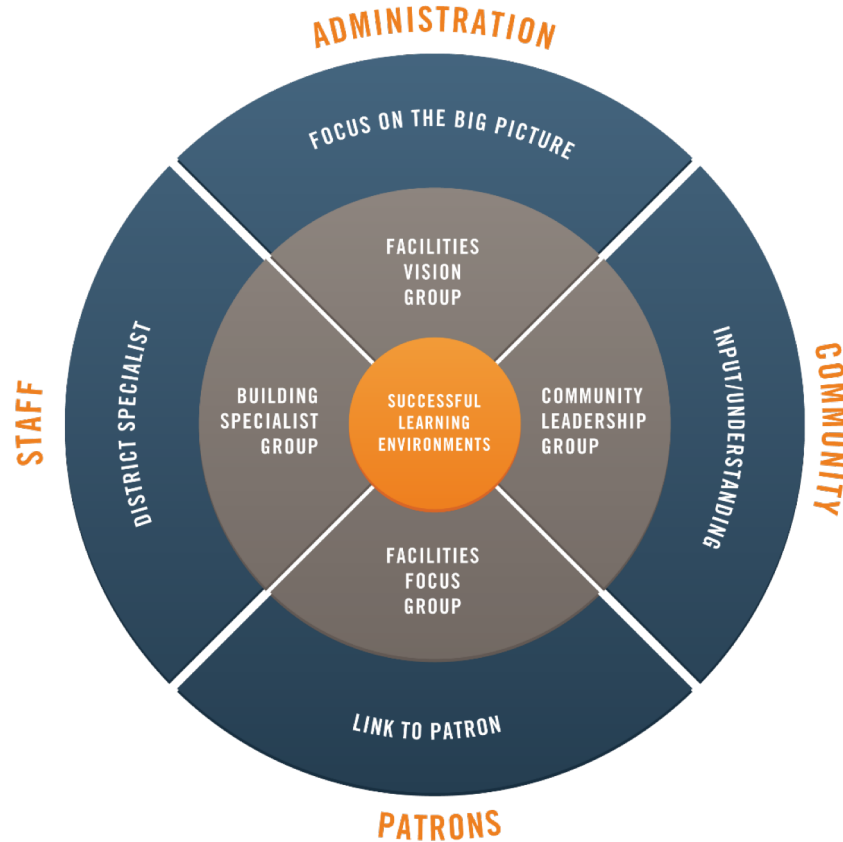
