### Student Recognition

 Both high schools held their final trister celebrations that included numerous give away items such as gift cards and electronics.

### • Scholarships – Dual Credit Tuition Assistance

 In partnership with RRT & SPA, the foundation will award \$9,972 to 49 students, representing 408 hours of college credit earned for 2017-18.

#### • Scholarships - Graduating Seniors - (See Scholarship Reception Program)

- The foundation distributed its scholarships during both high schools' Honors and Awards Night on May 1st.
- o The foundation held its annual reception for scholarship donors and recipients on May 15th.
  - Class of 2018 42 awards for 29 students totaling \$37,200
  - Previous Graduates 7 awards for 7 students totaling \$28,000
  - Tuition Checks for 2018-19 \$65,200
