Summary:

Assel Grant Services began working with Raytown Quality School in April 2019. Work complete in April and early May included learning about the school district's needs and conducting research on funding prospects which may fit those needs.

Two initial time sensitive deadlines became apparent, the Health Forward Foundation's (formerly the Health Care Foundation of Greater Kansas City) Mental Health Grant, which has both a letter of intent and full proposal deadline and the Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance STOP School Violence Technology and Threat Assessment Solutions for Safe Schools Program.

When these two proposals are complete, we will finish our research and develop a grant calendar based on the districts needs and available funding prospects.
