Raytown Educational Foundation Board of Trustees' Meeting Highlights for May 29, 2019

- **Student Recognition**
 - Both high schools held their final trister celebrations that included numerous give away items such as gift cards and electronics.
- **Scholarships – Dual Credit Tuition Assistance**
 - In partnership with RRT & SPA, the foundation will award \$9,522 to 49 students, representing 333 hours of college credit earned for 2018-19.
- **Scholarships - Graduating Seniors – (See Scholarship Reception Program)**
 - The foundation distributed its scholarships during both high schools' Honors and Awards Night on April 30, 2019.
 - The foundation held its annual reception for scholarship donors and recipients on May 15th.
 - Class of 2019 – 40 awards for 27 students totaling \$30,961
 - Previous Graduates – 7 awards for 7 students totaling \$24,000
 - Tuition Checks for 2019-20 - \$54,961
- **Teaching and Learning Grants – (See Chart)**
 - The foundation received 15 grant proposals requesting a total of \$24,247. The foundation selected 13 proposals to fund for 2019-20 totaling \$14,358. The foundation's Grant Patrol surprised the recipients with their large check on May 31st. A photo gallery of the recipients can be found on the foundation's Facebook page.
- **Class of 2019 Laptop Distribution**
 - Through a partnership with Raytown Quality Schools and its Board of Education, the foundation gifted to graduating seniors the computer issued to them during high school.
