


Face Coverings

Masks are optional for all Raytown Quality Schools students, staff and visitors.

Handwashing and Respiratory Etiquette

Frequent and adequate hand washing is recommended. Handwashing stations and hand sanitizers are available.

Individuals should cover their mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing followed by the washing of hands.

Contact Tracing

All positive staff and student COVID cases are reported to the Johnson County Health Department and/ or Kansas City Health Department.

Diagnosis and Return After a Positive COVID Test

Any staff or student with a positive COVID-19 test must stay home for five days and may return on day six (day zero is symptom onset date). If s/he has symptom improvement and is fever free for 24 hours. The staff/student will be required to wear a mask through day 10 once s/he returns.
