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# Strategic Plan – Goal 1.2 Student Achievement & College/Career Readiness

- Vision Area: Learning
- Vision Objective: Students will be co-creators of their career pathways, goals, and action plan
- Deliverable: Develop structures that enable every student to develop a six-year plan (ICAP) that aligns with career pathways, interests, and post-secondary goals.
- Project Title: Create a new Career and Education Planning Guide that will reflect an emphasis on career pathways and market value asset (MVA) acquisition for all students.
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# Progress on the Project

- Preliminary
  - Reviewing any work or ideas from the previous year
  - Researched other districts of similar size and demographics with Course Guide Designs
  - Met with leaders from other districts with Career Academy Models and reviewed their process and design.
- Team
  - Created a C-PEG Redesign Team
    - Tyler Britt – Curriculum Director, Erika Miller – Secondary Counselor Lead, Cheryl Reichert – Herndon CC Director, Kionna Dickerson – RHS RWL Coordinator, Terrence Fraizer – RSHS RWL Coordinator
- Design Format
  - Career Cluster Language & Symbols Embedded in CPEG
- Next Steps
  - Produce a prototype of the redesigned C-PEG (seek feedback) before finalizing.
  - PD for building staff on how to use career cluster information to help students/parents make informed decisions for course selections
  - Student revisit I-CAP and update progress and MVA goal

- By December 12, 2023, a New Career Pathway Course Guide, 90% of 9th-11th grade ICAPs initiated by the end of SY24
