  - Julio Bambini Memorial Scholarship Established by the Raytown Soccer Club to honor the memory of Julio Bambini. Julio was a founding member of the club and the driving force of the origin of youth soccer in the Raytown Community. Before her retirement, Julio's wife, Sue Bambini, served as the Raytown Quality Schools Board of Education Secretary.
  - William Hart Frederick "From the Heart" Scholarship Established by Bill's family and friends to honor Bill Frederick. Bill was supportive of education and served as a REF trustee for 20 years. Bill's wife, Sally Frederick is a Raytown High alumnus and taught at Raytown South High School for 31 years.
