State Track Results

Raytown South High School track and field student-athletes recently represented the District at the MSHSAA State Track and Field Meet on May 28. Quinton Rowell earned sixth place in the 400m Dash and Ja'Nyiah Davis earned fifth place in the high jump. Zaya Akins earned three state championship titles including the 100m Dash, 200m Dash and 400m Dash. Akins set new school records in the 100m Dash, 200m Dash and 400m Dash. Additionally, her times in all three events were the best in the state in all classes of competition. Akins time in the 400m Dash is ranked #20 in the nation and #1 nationally out of the 2023 graduating class. The 4x100m relay team of Nia Shields, Markayla Lottie, Tachelle Thomas, Zaya Akins also qualified for the state meet. The Cardinals also had the chance to meet up with Raytown South High alum and Olympian Maurice Mitchell while at the state meet.
