

## **Herndon Tuition Plan for FY24**

Beginning in 2014, we began using a sliding scale to allow districts to plan for their tuition for the next school year. In an effort to reduce sending school costs and encourage increased enrollment without significant additional cost expenditures, we adjust our tuition rates to be based on the actual enrollment on a yearly based on a graduated rate expense.

Since schools and students learned of acceptance by the end of March, we will produce an estimated tuition bill for the next school year by May 15 for all sending schools. By June 15, we would need a signature of understanding stating that the district understands that they will be billed for the students in the statement the following fall. If a student drops after that date and they are replaced, the school district will not incur the cost of the drop. If the student drops and cannot be replaced, the school would be responsible for the tuition. Any additional additions from the original tuition calculation through the beginning of the school year would be added to the tuition estimation to create the actual tuition bill that would be sent by September 15.

We instituted a student/parent commitment for the programs that require state certifications that prevent additions at the beginning of the school year and are full programs. The commitment for Cosmetology will be \$100, and the commitment for Foundations of Nursing will be \$50. This money will go directly to student fees incurred, so the student will have a reduced obligation in the fall. These commitments will be due prior to the estimated tuition bill being sent to the sending schools.

The actual tuition will be based on the number of students who enroll. The tuition costs will follow the graduated scale below:
