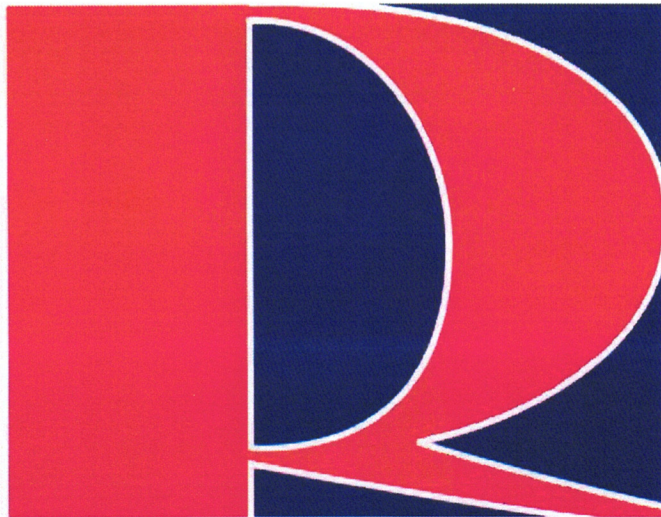

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Acoustic Grand Piano

Purpose

The Raytown C-2 School District is seeking an acoustic grand piano for the Raytown High School (RHS) Choral Room. The District seeks to retain the services of a company that will provide a comprehensive resource that would include a grand piano for the Raytown High School (RHS) Choral Room.

Proposal Guidelines

Response:

The Raytown C-2 School District requires a grand piano for the RHS choir room to replace the current 40-year-old model that is being used.

Cost:

Selection shall be made of the company deemed to be fully qualified and best suited among those submitting proposals on the basis of the evaluation factors included in the Request for Proposal (RFP), including price, if so stated in the proposal. Negotiations shall be conducted with the selected company. Price shall be considered, but need not be the sole determining factor. While we are not holding any company to a "not to exceed" amount, we do expect the company to be specific as to cost per item(s) and supports and to justify the expense of such items and supports.

Selection Criteria:

The district is seeking an acoustic grand piano for the Raytown High School Choral Room.

The piano should meet the following specifications:

- The piano should be manufactured by a reputable manufacturer who is dedicated to quality craftsmanship in their pianos.
- The piano should be an acoustic grand piano, at least 5’ 10” in length, suitable for both rehearsal and performance.
- Must include a piano bench, protective dust cover for the piano, and a dolly.
- Vendor must include delivery and set-up.
- Vendor provides tuning and maintenance services local to the Kansas City metropolitan area.

The following specifications are *preferred*, but not required:

DIMENSIONS

HEIGHT	40” (102 cm)
LENGTH	5’ 10” (178 cm)
WIDTH	59 3/4” (151 cm)
NET WEIGHT	660 lbs. (300 kg)

ENCASEMENT

FURNITURE	Ebonized. Natural finish over walnut or mahogany veneer.
PANEL STOCK	Multi-laminated lumber core (plywood); cross-banded veneer top and bottom of each panel.
LEGS	Solid beech.
FINISH	Polyester (Polished Finishes) or Nitrocellulose Lacquer (Satin Finishes).
HARDWARE	Solid brass, high-polished and lacquered.

INSTRUMENT

RIM	11 laminations of mahogany forming the outer rim and 17 laminations of Hard Rock maple forming the inner rim. Thickness to equal 2 3/8”.
BRACES	Three radiating braces
PINBLOCK	11 laminations of Hard Rock maple, each lamination to be a minimum of 1/8” in thickness. Grain symmetrically distributed at angles of 60 degrees. Pinblock should be fully fitted to plate flange, inspected for fit, and screwed to case structure.
SOUNDBOARD	Quarter-sawn, close-grained (minimum 8 grains/inch), solid Sitka spruce to be continuously tapered 8mm thick to 6mm thick from treble to bass.



RIBS	11 solid straight-grained spruce ribs. Ribs should be fully let-in to the inner rim to lock in the soundboard crown.
BRIDGES	Treble: made of alternating mahogany and maple, vertically laminated, capped with solid maple, curved to fit crown of soundboard. Bass: Solid maple mounted to cantilever base. Both bridges are planed to prescribed customized height and notched for precise individual string bearing, glued and screwed to soundboard.
SCALE	Overstrung: combination agraffe; front and rear duplex. Tension: 34,958 lbs. (15,980 kg)
PLATE	Made from gray iron; vacuum cast, bronzed and lacquered.
TUNING PINS	Premium nickel-plated steel with cut threads.
STRINGS	Treble: 12 wire sizes. Bass: Longest agraffe to bridge 53.5”.
HAMMERS	20.9 lb. premium wool outer-felt; over premium wool under-felt, treated for insects and moisture; compression-wire-reinforced to retain pear shape.
DAMPERS	Solid mahogany heads with premium wool.
ACTION	Made from solid maple (no plastic) for all moving parts.
KEYS	Key material should consist of genuine spruce, individually balanced and weighted, covered with chip-proof, stain-resistant synthetic ebony sharps and synthetic ivory naturals.
KEYBED	Laminated hardwood faced with spruce. large maple dowel ends for adjustable brass touch-regulating screws. 1.68” (42mm) in thickness.
KEYFRAME plates	Made from spruce with hardwood inserts in the balance rail and front rail. keyblock With height adjustment screws.
PEDALS	Heavy solid brass. Soft, full sostenuto, and damper.
OTHER	Double top prop sticks, soft-fall fallboard, top locks, heavy-duty solid brass casters and four-position music desk.

Award:

Selection shall be issued to the company meeting the global needs of the students in the Raytown School District. Award shall be made to the company meeting the established selection criteria and containing the most progressive technological components established within the negotiated price. Selection shall be made of the company deemed to be fully qualified and best suited among those submitting proposals on the basis of the evaluation factors included in the RFP, including price. Negotiations shall be conducted with the company selected and may include necessary changes to the company’s Terms of Use and Privacy Policy for the digital learning components of the resource including third party components to ensure alignment with District’s data security guidelines. Price shall be considered, but need not be the sole determining factor.

The District will withhold 20% from the final payment as retainage until all online services are fully functional,

as written in the proposal, in the educational setting.

General District Information

Student Population:

The Raytown C-2 School District's enrollment is approximately 8,500 students Pre-Kindergarten through grade 12. There are three primary diverse populations: African American (49%), Caucasian (28%), and Hispanic (13%). The free and reduced lunch rate for the District is 65% with a mobility rate of approximately 20%. Currently, 15% of students receive special educational services.

Facilities/Technology Availability:

The district has a total of 2 high schools, 3 middle schools, 10 elementary schools, 2 pre-k schools, 1 career center, 1 school for students with exceptional needs, and 1 alternative school. The district provides students with access to the following technology devices for use in curricular activities: laptops with the Windows operating system for each student in grades 9-12, Chromebooks for all students in grades 6-8 and class sets of Chromebooks for elementary students grades 2-5. Students in K-1 are 3:1 with Chromebooks. The district also continues to move toward the use of web-based applications. All certified district staff have Windows 7 laptops as well as SMART Boards (or interactive whiteboard). All district buildings have complete wireless coverage.

Instructional staff:

The certificated staff is diverse in years of service and level of education with the average years of teaching experience at approximately 11 years. Approximately 57% of certificated staff hold a Master's degree or advanced Master's degree(s). It is necessary to provide a curricular resource that differentiates instructional strategies and techniques that will support the novice teacher as well as provide a menu of options for the veteran teacher.

Finances:

Raytown School District will prefer delivery of materials on or before November 1st, 2023, but will work with selected vendor to confirm official dates upon selection.


